Versiti to Host 23rd Annual Dennis Buckley Memorial Blood Drive at the 2021 Chicago Auto Show

Donating blood takes about an hour with the actual donation taking 10-15 minutes. Anyone age 17 or older in good health who meets eligibility requirements is encouraged to give.
